



SPOTTING MISINFORMATION

CONSIDER THE SOURCE

Is this a credible source of information? Who created the information and what are their motives? What is the intention of the information? Does the domain or the URL name seem strange or similar to another well-known website?



CONSIDER THE STYLE

Misinformation is often written to grab attention and encourage people to share. Is the headline shocking or emotive? Consider if it is written as fact, opinion or even parody? Is it clickbait? Read the full article, not just the headline.

CHECK MULTIPLE SOURCES

Check the accuracy of the story by comparing with other sources. Are they all saying the same thing? Get a second opinion.



FACT CHECK

There are a number of independent fact checking websites, such as Full Fact or Snopes who investigate and review information on trending and topical issues to expose misinformation.
