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Windows 10	Windows 10 is the latest Operating System from Microsoft, that can be installed on your school computers. It is more secure than Windows 7 and provides a modern environment in which to learn and work.	 Familiar to pupils and staff. Works on desktops and laptops. Built-in security.
Outlook	The online version of your email and calendar available from any device. Never run out of inbox space with a 50Gb mailbox. Enhanced security controls built in to protect your sensitive data. Sway	A digital storytelling application that presents ideas on screen in an interactive and intuitive way. Easily embed images, text and video into an online presentation.
