

Houseparty is a social networking service that allows users to connect with up to 8 people at a time through mobile and desktop apps.



Users can integrate Houseparty with Snapchat and Facebook. Users can invite friends to a room via SMS too. Users can gain 'wins' for doing secret tasks and can upload Bitmoji's.



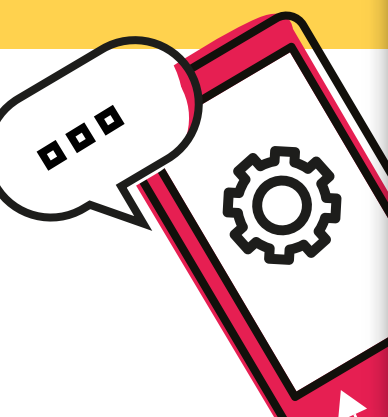
Users can chat with multiple people at the same time. Quizzes and games can be played during a video call. Users can use a 'ghost' mode to anonymously visit rooms.
