

- In Christmas Crib Service they visit a Church in Wales church in mid-December and take part in a special Christmas service.
- In Easter Family Service they visit a Presbyterian Church of Wales service in the spring and take part in a special Easter service.
- In Harvest Thanksgiving they visit a Baptist chapel in the autumn and bring gifts to the Harvest Thanksgiving.
- In Wedding Service they visit a Church in Wales church when Aled is an usher and Siân is a bridesmaid.
- In Baptism Service they visit a Roman Catholic Church when their baby cousin Nia is baptised.
- In The Big Chapel they discover a large chapel which is used by all the local denominations to serve the needs of the community.

helps people.




On Monday evening Siân and Aled go
