## TALK PEDAGOGY – Autumn Term 2022 A safe place to talk and think together.





The Welsh Government in collaboration with schools, the Regional Education Consortia, local authorities, National Academy for Educational Leadership and Higher Education Institutions will continue to host a wide range of pedagogy conversations and provide opportunities for people to engage through networks, programmes and enquiry projects. Increasingly, this will allow the range of local and regional networks that already exist to be the driving force of Talk Pedagogy and feed into the national collaborative <u>Talk Pedagogy community</u>.

For the Autumn Term we are planning two main programmes of activity with each based around a 'big ticket' theme. Each will begin with a main event that will then stimulate a range of activity that will continue into the Spring Term and support schools to go deeper into the main theme.

The themes for the Autumn Term are:

- Exploring pedagogy to build learner effectiveness, including metacognition and self-regulation
- Exploring pedagogy to build confidence and skills in the use of Cymraeg

Schools can plan their interaction with the programme of activity and build this into their school based professional learning. We would encourage you to come along to live sessions as this provides an opportunity to hear first-hand from others, talk through ideas and perhaps form links for further conversations and visits beyond the online community. The main input from each session will also be recorded and made available in the Talk Pedagogy community.

In addition, to the 'big ticket' themes there will also be other sessions made available to focus on continuing some of the channels from 2021-2022 and other areas as they become available. All member of Talk Pedagogy will automatically receive invites to these as they arise.
